BUILDING UPDATE

Concrete has been poured for the new children's play area between the existing and new children's building. This is where the prayer garden was located before construction.

The brick for the two new buildings arrived in early January and is nearing completion along with the plaster. You will notice we no longer have the outer aqua color showing!!

Drainage is being installed for the memorial prayer garden. The irrigation pipes, valves, fixtures, etc can then be installed. The concrete foundation for the prayer garden floor and cross will also be poured soon.

The electrical connections in the new buildings are in the process of being completed. The HVAC system has been hooked up and if you have noticed, we now have heat in the hallway outside of Room 206.

Now that the HVAC system is in place, the finish work can begin, such as flooring and cabinetry.
