BUILDING UPDATE

The BUMC members on the building committee and sub-committees, representatives from Gaeke Construction, and Slattery Architects met for our monthly meeting February 15. We reviewed the status of the Phase 2 project and agreed the estimated completion date of March 31 was still attainable provided we don't get another unscheduled event. All

present are dedicated to doing everything we can to meet or beat that date.

The restrooms in both new buildings are near complete, work is continuing on HVAC and electrical. The flooring began going in this week (February 22). The next step will be to install the work tables and cabinets and then to paint.

Work on the landscaping has begun, including the new corner sign at Austin and Masonic Streets. The current sign in front of the sanctuary will be cleaned up and repaired.

Discussion continues for the new playground areas for children and youth, and an outdoor kitchen area.

Renovations in the Welcome Center will begin on March 3.
