



Welcome back to the Bellville Methodist Newsletter! After all the busyness of disaffiliation, moving into and slowly getting settled into the new construction, and just summer in general, we're back!

As we launch into Fall, Wednesday nights Discipleship courses are gearing up. You'll find details about the Children's Programming inside, but here, I want to let you know about two studies Scott Maddox and I will be leading together:

"Methodism 101" is going to be a look at the basics of Methodism - history, beliefs, practices, and your questions. It will last 4 weeks. There will be a Wednesday at 6 pm section beginning September 6 and a Sunday at 4 pm section beginning September 10. Please let us know in the church office if you are interested in attending one of them so we can pick the right sized space.

"Scripture and the Wesleyan Way: A Bible Study on Real Christianity" is an 8 session course using the book of the same name authored by Bishop Scott Jones and his son Arthur Jones. (https://www.amazon.com/Scripture-Wesleyan-Way-Bible-Christianity/dp/1501867938/) Topics include: What is the Bible's Message? How Can I Be Saved? Am I a Real Christian? Do I Have to Obey the Law? Am I a Sinner? How Can I Connect with God? Why is the Christian Life Not Easier? What about My Money? The study be on Wednesdays at 6 pm beginning October 18. Please let us know if you are interested in attending. You can either order the book directly or we can order them for \$15 which will help cover the cost of the DVD for the course. (And if you are interested in attending but can't make Wednesday nights, let us know that as well. We might open up a section at a different time if there is enough need.)
